### Sermon Guide

#### Two Myths the Rich Young Ruler Believes About Money

1. Money is separate from \_\_\_\_\_.  
*"Teacher, I have kept all these since my youth." (v.12)*
2. My money is my \_\_\_\_\_.  
*When he heard this, he was shocked and went away grieving, for he had many possessions. (v.22)*

#### Two Truths Jesus Reveals about Money

1. Money can \_\_\_\_\_ us from God.  
*Jesus said, "It is easier for a camel to go through the eye of a needle than for someone who is rich to enter the kingdom of God." (v.25)*
2. Generosity is \_\_\_\_\_.  
*Jesus, looking at him, loved him and said, "You lack one thing; go, sell what you own, and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; then come, follow me." (v.21)*
