## A Word from Pastor Eric

This week, Diane Adams shared this quote with me from *Liturgy of the Ordinary* by Tish Harrison Warren.

In overlooked moments and routines, we can become aware of God's presence in surprising ways. How do we embrace the sacred in the ordinary and the ordinary in the sacred?

I am aware we are moving towards new patterns of ordinary in a world that remains unfamiliar. Venturing out to the grocery store is one of the most ordinary of tasks. We have our grocery list, we walk down a familiar aisle, we purchase our goods and we finally walk the bags to place in our car. Ordinary. Familiar.

Yet, now each trip to the grocery store contains new changes in a world I never expected. A few weeks ago, few people wore masks, now its more uncommon to see someone without one. One week I walked into the store and there were directional arrows on each aisle to keep shoppers from passing each other. The next week, a screen shielded me from the cashier. The ordinary today is simply more change not less.

Which brings me back to the quote above. When change is the expected experience, it gives us more opportunity to be surprised by God's presence. We can embrace the sacred around us because we are able to see it more clearly. The longer we walk this journey into the unknown ramifications of pandemic, the more accustomed we are to the beauty of new things.

This week let me invite us to embrace the sacred in the ordinary parts of our lives. Look around each day and ask the Lord, "where will you surprise me today?" I have not doubt you will be.

And ... if you are feeling lonely, frustrated, stressed out, tired, done with all of this, remember ... you are not alone. Take time to connect to your CARE ring. And when needed, reach out to me. We can Facetime, talk on the phone or even have a prayer over Zoom. Together, we WILL make it through these days.
